What is composite bonding?

Is composite bonding suitable for me?

How long does composite bonding treatment take?

This treatment can often be completed in one surgery visit, following your check-up + cosmetic consultation appointment.

How long does composite bonding treatment last?

Typically, you can expect composite bonding to last for 5-7 years with a good oral health regime. However, this depends on a range of factors, including how well you look after your teeth, patients grinding teeth, and any trauma to your teeth.

Does composite bonding hurt?

No. Composite bonding is minimally invasive and pain-free. There is usually no need for drilling of your existing teeth, or for anaesthesia.
